

TOM GREEN

Composer

Tom Green's career in music spans three decades, from playing keyboards with cult punk outfit **Dum Dum Dum** and Sierra Leonian guitar maestro **Abdul Dejan Talloh** in the '80s, to working with No 1 charting ambient dub pioneers **The Orb** on five albums from the '90s to the present day. His solo project **Another Fine Day** has produced three critically-acclaimed albums so far, the album "Life Before Land" being voted No 3 in The Independent's *Greatest Ambient Albums* chart in 2009.

Along the way he has also worked with and co-produced world music act **Baka Beyond**, remixed artists such as **Natacha Atlas**, **Kitten & The Hip** and **Alucidnation** (also a Faber-signed electronica artist). Tom has composed extensively for TV, film, music libraries and corporate media, and is an alumnus of Faber Music *Media Music Academy* from 2012.
