Carl Davis

Biographical notes

A consummate all-round musician, Carl Davis is widely known in many spheres of international music-making. Born in New York in 1936, he studied composition with Paul Nordoff and Hugo Kauder, and subsequently with Per Nørgaard in Copenhagen. His early work in the USA provided valuable conducting experience with organizations such as New York City Opera and the Robert Shaw Chorale. In 1959 the revue **Diversions**, of which he was co-author, won an off-Broadway Obie and subsequently travelled to the 1961 Edinburgh Festival and in 1962 to London (Arts Theatre). As a direct result of its success there, Davis was commissioned by Ned Sherrin to write music for "That Was The Week That Was". Other radio and TV commissions followed and Davis's UK career was launched.

Since then he has been enormously successful in the world of theatre, composing scores for, among others, the Royal Shakespeare Company, the National Theatre, and the West End, and working closely with artists of the calibre of Laurence Olivier, John Gielgud, Joan Littlewood, Jonathan Miller, John Wells, Barry Humphries and Billy Connolly.

Davis is equally well-known in the field of dance. He began working with London Contemporary Dance Theatre, producing scores for **David and Goliath** (1975) and **Dances of Love and Death** (1981). Sadlers Wells Royal Ballet commissioned **A Picture of Dorian Gray** in 1987, and this was followed by commissions from Northern Ballet Theatre - the award-winning **A Simple Man** (1988), **Lippizaner** and **Liaisons Amoureuses** (1989) and **A Christmas Carol** based on Dickens' (1992). His ballet based on Sullivan, **Savoy Suite**, choreographed by Wayne Sleep, re-opened the restored Savoy Theatre. His most recent full-length ballet, **Alice and Wonderland** (1995), commissioned by the English National Ballet, is based on themes by Tchaikovsky.

Davis's output for film and television is vast, including **The World At War, The Snow Goose, Hotel du Lac, Hollywood, Naked Civil Servant, Silas Marner, Champions, Scandal, The Commanding Sea, Oppenheimer, The Rainbow, The French Lieutenant's Woman (the winner of both the BAFTA and Ivor Novello awards), Pride and Prejudice** (nominated for a BASCA Ivor Novello award for 'Best Music For a Television Production' in 1996), and more recently **Cold War** and **Real Women**.

His 1980 score for Abel Gance's epic 5-hour silent film **Napoleon** triggered an extraordinary revival of interest in the silent film, and Davis's oeuvre of more than thirty scores for this medium (many of them commissioned by Channel Four), including **Flesh and the Devil**, **Ben-Hur**, **The Thief of Bagdad**, **Greed** and **Intolerance**, has brought him international acclaim, through live performances, TV broadcasts and recordings. The classic Lon Chaney silent, **Phantom of the Opera**, was enthusiastically received in Edinburgh and at the London Film Festival in 1996, whilst a new score to Harold Lloyd's great comedy **The Freshman** was premiered in Holland in 1998. The 1998 London Film Festival saw the premiere of **The Wedding March** (Eric von Stroheim).

Throughout his career he has composed concert works, among which a **Clarinet Concerto**, **Fantasy for Flute**, **Strings and Harpsichord** and a **Symphony** are particularly notable.

There are also many concert suites derived from film scores, vocal music, choral works, instrumental and chamber music, and opera. In 1991 his first collaboration with Paul McCartney produced **Paul McCartney's Liverpool Oratorio**, now being performed in many countries throughout the world. The EMI recording of the work has achieved record sales world-wide, whilst the BBC documentary and EMI's commercial video have done much to publicize this new departure for both composers.

Suffice to say that Davis has recorded widely with a great number of orchestras, most notably the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, London Philharmonic Orchestra, English Chamber Orchestra and the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra. His recording activities have included many discs of his own music - one recent success was a complete Davis disc for Tring Records featuring the premiere recording of the **Variations** on a Polish Beggar's Song and excerpts from many of his film and television scores. Two albums celebrating his Leeds Castle concerts were also been released to much acclaim in 1992 and 1997. Leeds Castle commissioned a new piece, **On**

the Beach at Night Alone, for performance in their summer concerts in 1999. It will be included on a third Leeds Castle album to be released at the same time.

In 1993 Davis was invited to be Artistic Director and Conductor for the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra's Summer "Pops" Season. This was an enormous success and is now an annual event in Liverpool. During the last six years this series of concerts has become more innovative and exciting with the creation of new concepts for the concert platform, many of them featuring Davis's own concert music. Further evidence of the high regard in which he is held in the UK was shown when the BBC invited him to present a thirteen week series for Radio 2 entitled "Carl Davis Classics". It was so successful that a second series has already been broadcast and a third will follow, becoming an annual event. Further proof came in 1998, when, at the request of Woking Borough Council, Davis also programmed an inaugural series of four concerts with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra on a local football ground.

His position in the world of film and television music has long been assured. With such an important foothold in classical music he should be better placed than ever to bridge the gap between the two.

He has been honoured on both sides of the Atlantic for his work as a composer and conductor. In 1992 he received an Honorary Fellowship from Liverpool University and in 1994 he was awarded an Honorary Doctor of Arts by his old college in New York, Bard.

Carl's permanent home is now in London. He is married to actress, Jean Boht and they have two daughters, Hannah and Jessie.


