Nicholas Singer is an **EMMY** nominated composer from London UK, with 17 years experience of scoring music for film, television, theatre, videogames and installations.

He has worked on a wide variety of projects with varying subjects and requirements, from ambient music in the London and Paris Aquariums, to documentaries for **HBO** and the **BBC**-from films for Amnesty International, The New York Times and the Guardian, to commercials for Saatchi & Saatchi and Santander.

In 2015 Nicholas was nominated for Best Composition in Feature Film at the International **Music & Sound Awards**, for his work on the critically acclaimed HBO feature documentary **Night Will Fall**, the story behind the film made by Allied troops in 1945 of the horrors they witnessed in concentration camps, that was never shown.

He is currently working on *Where The Wind Blew*, a feature documentary from the team behind Night Will Fall, about Soviet nuclear testing in Kazakhstan. Nicholas is also working on *Neanderthal Fight Club*, a BBC documentary series in association with Andy Serkis & The Imaginarium.

He studied music at Oxford University and composition at the National Film and Television School (NFTS).
