STEPHEN WARBECK

Composer

Stephen Warbeck is one of the best-known film composers working in Britain today. His many credits include *Shakespeare in Love* (Miramax), for which he won the Academy Award, *Captain Corelli's Mandolin* (Working Title/Universal), *Billy Elliot* (Tiger Aspect/Working Title), *The Other Man* (Rainmark Films), *Quills* (Industry Entertainment/Fox Searchlight), *Mrs Brown* (Ecosse Films/Miramax) and *My Son the Fanatic* (BBC/Zephyr Films/Miramax).

Stephen's most recent scores include **DNA**, written and directed by Maïwenn, which received a **César Award** nomination for Original Score, **Uncle Vanya**, starring Toby Jones and Richard Armitage for BBC Arts, Richard Eyre's **The Children Act**, starring Emma Thompson and Stanley Tucci, and **Hampstead**, for Ecosse Films, starring Brendan Gleeson and Diane Keaton.

In 2020, Stephen wrote and directed his first feature, *The Man In The Hat;* a music filled road movie following the titular character, played by Ciaran Hinds, as he finds himself on a car chase through the French countryside.

Stephen began studying piano and composing at the age of four, and by his mid-teens he had developed an affinity for rock 'n' roll as well as for theatre.

His television credits include the first five series of Lynda La Plante's *Prime Suspect*, for which he received a **BAFTA** nomination, his score for *The Dresser* for the BBC, starring Ian McKellen and Anthony Hopkins, and both series of Channel 4's prestigious primetime drama *Indian Summers*. He has also written music for numerous theatre productions including *Wolf Hall/Bring up the Bodies* (RSC), *Jerusalem* (The Royal Court), *The Tempest* (Globe), *This House* (National) and productions at the Almeida and the Royal Court. Stephen is a founder member of *The hKippers*, with whom he still regularly performs.
